ALL ACCOUNTS are due and payable upon the due date as shown on the statement of account and delinquent accounts shall be subject to additional charges as levied by the Town from time to time and delinquent accounts shall be subject to being discontinued.

THE UNDERSIGNED acknowledges that the Town may place any bills that are ninety (90) days or more in arrears from the due date on the Municipal Tax Roll for collection as provided for in the Public Utilities Act (R.S.O. Chp P52 1990 as amended).

The Town agrees to use reasonable diligence in supplying a regular and uninterrupted supply of water and sewer services but will not be liable for damages to the customers for reason of failure to do so no matter how caused.
