



Public Skating Rules

All patrons who participate in ice skating programs must respect the following rules:

- Children 7 years of age or younger must be directly supervised by a participating responsible individual 16 years of age or older.
- No food or drink on the ice surface
- No horseplay/games
- No figure skating maneuvers
- No erratic/excessive speed skating
- No balls, pucks, chairs, strollers, sticks or any other item which might interfere with the safety of any skater while on the ice surface.
- No headsets. Cell phones or hand-held electronic device are to be used while skating
- No carrying of children is permitted
- No sitting on boards
- Skate with the direction of all skaters
- Conduct appropriate behaviour at all times
- All participants must be wearing skates while on the ice surface
- For all children, it is strongly recommended that a CSA approved helmet be worn
- Please exit the ice surface promptly when the buzzer rings

These policies are for the safety and enjoyment of all participants. Throughout the season the arenas are used for tournaments, competitions and special events which may result in the cancellation of regular programs. Watch for details in the local paper and postings in the arena.
