



Quick facts about on-road All-Terrain Vehicle / Off Road Vehicle use within the Town of Deseronto & the new Provincial ATV/ORV Laws (effective July 1st, 2015).

Drivers operating a permitted ATV/ORV along a road or highway MUST:

- Must be at least 16 years old and hold at least a G2 or M2 driver's licence
- The ATV/ORV must be registered and insured and display a rear licence plate
- All riders including drivers and passengers of all ages will have to wear a helmet and use a seatbelt or foot rests, where applicable
- Passengers cannot be under the age of eight
- Drivers must abide to a speed limit of 20km or less
